#### **ORDER ON THE ACCUSED'S MOTION FOR SAFE CONDUCT ORDER OR SUBPOENA: DRAGAN KIJAC**

On 4 November 2013, the Chamber granted the Karadžić's motion and ordered safe conduct for witness Dragan Kijac throughout his trip to The Netherlands for the purpose of testimony in this case.

#### **DECISION ON ACCUSED'S MOTION TO VARY LIST OF WITNESSES: SREBRENICA & MUNICIPALITIES COMPONENTS**

On 4 November 2013, the Chamber granted the Karadžić's motion for an addition of two witnesses related to the Srebrenica events as well as the withdrawal of 98 municipalities-related ones from his witness list.

#### **ORDER FOR THE AGENDA OF THE APPEAL HEARING**
