LAST MINUTE NEWS

“KORDIC AND CERKEZ” CASE:

TRIAL DATE SET:

Following a closed status conference held on Friday 8 January 1999, Trial Chamber III (Judge May, presiding, Judge Bennouna and Judge Robinson) issued a scheduling order stating that: “*subject to further order, the trial in this matter shall commence on Monday 12 April 1999, at 10 a.m.*”.

“BOSANSKI SAMAC” CASE:

FURTHER INITIAL APPEARANCE HEARING:

Following the confirmation of a second amended indictment against Blagoje Simic, Milan Simic, Miroslav Tadic, Stevan Todorovic and Simo Zaric (see Update no. 59 of 18 December 1998), a further initial appearance hearing will be held on Thursday 21 January 1999 at 2.30 p.m. for Stevan Todorovic. Stevan Todorovic will be requested to plead to the additional charges in the second indictment. His co-accused will be present, save Milan Simic, who has been provisionally released and who will be represented by his counsel, and Blagoje Simic, who remains at large.
