I, **FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the “Order Assigning a Case to a Trial Chamber”, issued on 11 June 2008 (“Order”), whereby I assigned the case of *Prosecutor v. Stojan Župljanin*, Case No. IT-99-36-I, to Trial Chamber II;

CONSIDERING that the word “permanent” in the last sentence of the Order should be deleted;

HEREBY ORDER that the last sentence of the Order read “RECALL also that, pursuant to Rule 62 of the Rules, the initial appearance of the Accused shall be held without delay before Trial Chamber II or a Judge thereof”.
