ICTY seeks qualified applicants for a Consultancy for a Photographer during the Legacy Conference.

Only candidates under consideration will be contacted. The selected candidate will be offered a consultant's contract.

Organizational setting and Reporting:

This position is located in the Communications Unit of the Registry of the International Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY) in The Hague, The Netherlands under the supervision of the Chief, Communications Section.

Work Location Sarajevo

Expected duration

The duration of the assignment shall be in the period 22-24 June, 2017, with extended period for the post production, adding up to a total of no more than 4 days.

Terms of Reference for Consultant

Within delegated authority, the Photographer will be responsible for the following duties:

- Providing photography services needed for the ICTY Legacy Conference events such as panels and discussions, side events, receptions, media opportunities and the ICTY stock footage;
- Providing edited high-resolution photographs for the ICTY promotional and stock usage, and edited low-resolution photographs when immediate social media sharing is required;
- Works closely with the Communications Unit, ensuring that the services are being carried out according to the expectations of the Chief, Communications Section;
- Ensures that all course deadlines are adhered to;
- Adaptability to work in a multicultural environment;
- Ability to work independently;
- A good standard of computer literacy;
- Any other photography related duties as assigned.

The Photographer will operate under the following parameters:

- The duration of the assignment shall be in the period 22-24 June, 2017, with extended period for the post production, adding up to a total of no more than 4 days.
- The photographer will be booked for a period of time up to a full day in the period 22-24 June, 2017,
- Types of photographs required include, but are not limited to: Headshots; Group photos, anywhere between 2 and 500 people, either indoors or outdoors; Event photographs, either indoors or outdoors, of: audience, speakers, brand elements;
- Apart from the photographs themselves, the services should include: Post production (colour correction, etc.);
- Digital delivery of the product, to include: Edited high-resolution JPEG (maximum size at 300dpi, RGB, quality 100%); Edited low-resolution JPEG (1000 pixels wide for the longest side, 72dpi, RGB, quality 80%) when immediate social media sharing is required;
- The delivery should be done in electronic format within the next 24-48 hours after they were taken, depending on the urgency of delivery. Photos for distribution on social media will be needed, and as such, these will need to be delivered immediately, usually during the event, or at most one hour after the event;

QUALIFICATIONS/Special Skills

Education:

Relevant qualifications in the fields of photography and photography post-production, respectively, technical experience, knowledge and capability in the area of photography as well as the ability to prepare and deliver final edited versions of the photographs.

Experience:

Minimum of 7 years of progressively responsible professional experience at either the national or international level, preferably with an emphasis in high profile official events photography, group and portraits photography. Experience in photography related to transitional justice topics and the ICTY events is advantage.

Language:

English and French are the working languages of the Tribunal. For the post advertised, fluency in oral and written English and B/C/S is required.

- 1) Qualified candidates who are able to work on short notice in Sarajevo, Bosnia, are invited to submit their application and their UN Personal History Form (PHP), to recruitment@icty.org quoting the job opening number in the subject line.
- 2) A list and description of recent activities (in the last 3 years) in the field of photography composition and editing; including at least 3 examples of projects on subjects related to this opening. No fewer than 3 photographs may be submitted for each of the projects submitted as examples of work.

Once received, a list of candidates who meet the requirements of the post will be sent to the supervisor, who will prepare a written comparative analysis of the candidates and make a recommendation for the position.
