ALEKSOVSKI JUDGMENT ON 7 MAY 1999

On 5 May 1999, Judge Almiro Simoes Rodrigues, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber I *bis* (further comprised of Judges Vohrah and Nieto Navia) issued an Order in the case *The Prosecutor v. Zlatko Aleksovski*, stating that “*the Judges of the Trial Chamber deem that at this stage of their deliberations it is important to convene a hearing in the presence of the accused, the Prosecution and Defence counsel as quickly as possible so that they may pronounce their Judgment*”.

For this reason Judge Rodrigues ordered that the parties appear before the Trial Chamber on Friday 7 May 1999 at 9.00 am at a public hearing. The hearing will take place in Courtroom I.
