ADDENDUM TO THE ORDER APPOINTING A PRE-TRIAL JUDGE

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the International Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Prosecution’s Motion for Joinder” filed by the Office of the Prosecutor on 11 September 2001;

NOTING the “Order appointing a pre-trial Judge” issued by this Trial Chamber on 28 November 2001 (“the Order of 28 November”), temporarily appointing Judge O-Gon Kwon as pre-trial Judge in this case;

CONSIDERING, however, that the “Ordonnance du Président portant affectation temporaire d’un juge d’une chambre de première instance à une autre” filed on 26 November 2001 assigned Judge O-Gon Kwon to Trial Chamber II in the case of *the Prosecutor v. Vidoje Blagojević* and for the limited purpose of ruling on the Prosecution’s Motion for Joinder;


NOTING Rule 65ter of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“the Rules”) which provides that the Presiding Judge of the Trial Chamber shall “designate from among its permanent members a Judge responsible for the pre-trial proceedings” (“the pre-trial Judge”);

PURSUANT TO Rule 65ter of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS that:

- notwithstanding the functions entrusted to Judge O-Gon Kwon by the Order of 28 November;
- the pre-trial Judge for all other matters relating to this case shall be Judge Schomburg;
