I, Kevin Parker, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

BEING SEIZED of the Prosecutor’s Motion to Lift the Seal on the Indictment, Decision on Review of Indictment and Order for Non Disclosure, and Warrants of Arrest pursuant to Rules 53 and 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");

HAVING REVIEWED and **CONSIDERED** the Prosecutor’s Motion and reasons for lifting the seal of the Indictment, Decision and Order, and Warrants;

AND FINDING that because the two accused are in protective custody in Croatia and this fact is now in the public domain, no valid purpose is served in keeping the documents sealed, and the interests of justice are now best served by making these documents public.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- (a) In accordance Rules 53 and 54, the Indictment, Decision and Order, and Warrants shall now be made public;
- (b) Pursuant to Rule 53, the supporting material shall remain under seal to the public until further order.
