
**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**NOTING** that the Accused pled guilty to both counts of the Indictment at his further appearance in this case on 26 August 2011;

**CONSIDERING** that Rule 62 *bis* of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) *inter alia* provides for a number of requirements which the Trial Chamber must be satisfied about before entering a finding of guilt;
