**ORDER REASSIGNING A CASE TO A TRIAL CHAMBER AND ASSIGNING AD LITEM  
JUDGES FOR PRE-TRIAL WORK**

**I, FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the “Order Assigning a Case to a Trial Chamber” issued by the President of the International Tribunal on 25 February 2005, which assigned this case to Trial Chamber III;

**NOTING** the “Order Assigning an Ad Litem Judge for Pre-Trial Work” issued on 12 May 2006, which assigned *ad litem* Judge Frank Höpfel to conduct pre-trial work in this case;

**NOTING** the “Order Assigning an Ad Litem Judge for Pre-Trial Work” issued on 12 May 2006, which assigned *ad litem* Judge Krister Thelin to conduct pre-trial work in this case;

**NOTING** the “Order Regarding Composition of Trial Chamber and Designating a Pre-Trial Judge” issued on 16 May 2006 by the Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber III assigning a Trial Chamber Bench and designating *ad litem* Judge Krister Thelin as Pre-Trial Judge;

**NOTING** that on 25 November 2005, the Secretary-General of the United Nations appointed Judge Janet Nosworthy, to serve as an *ad litem* Judge in the case of *Prosecutor v. Milan Martić*, Case No. IT-95-11-PT, in Trial Chamber I, effective 29 November 2005, on which she presently sits;

**NOTING** Security Council resolution 1481 (2003), which authorizes *ad litem* Judges to adjudicate in pre-trial proceedings in cases other than those they have been appointed to try;

**NOTING** that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;

**CONSIDERING** the trial management and case distribution needs of the International Tribunal;

**HEREBY REASSIGN**, with immediate effect, *Prosecutor v. Rasim Delić*, Case No. IT-04-83-PT, to Trial Chamber I; **ASSIGN** *ad litem* Judge Janet Nosworthy to *Prosecutor v. Rasim Delić*, Case No. IT-04-83-PT, for purposes of pre-trial work to replace *ad litem* Judge Frank Höpfel; and **AFFIRM** that *ad litem* Judge Krister Thelin will continue to conduct pre-trial work in this case as reassigned to Trial Chamber I.
