

1. The Prosecution withdraws from its 22 January 2008 "Prosecution Motion to Reconsider 'Decision on Prosecution Submission on the Admission of Documentary Evidence'" its motion to admit Proposed Exhibits P01454 and P03023.<sup>1</sup> The Prosecution is satisfied that Proposed Exhibit P01454 is identical to Defence document D00235, admitted into evidence as Exhibit 278 on 28 August 2007; and that P03023 is identical to Defence document D00573, admitted into evidence as Exhibit 594 on 15 October 2007.
