**TRIAL CHAMBER I** (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991;

**BEING SEISED** of the Prosecution “Motion to Vary ‘Decision on Sixth Prosecution Motion for Admission of Evidence Pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*’” filed on 9 January 2008 (“Motion”);

**CONSIDERING** that in its Motion, the Prosecution asks the Trial Chamber to vary its “Decision on Sixth Prosecution Motion for Admission of Evidence Pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*” rendered on 11 December 2007 and admit the statement of witness Ivan Negovetić in its full, unredacted form;


**CONSIDERING** that witness Ivan Negovetić is scheduled to appear for cross-examination on Tuesday, 15 January 2008 while, according to Rule 126 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Defence is entitled to file a response within fourteen days of the filing of the Motion;

**CONSIDERING** that it would be appropriate for the Defence to file a response, if any, as soon as possible so as to enable a decision on the Motion in good time;

**PURSUANT** to Rules 54, 126 *bis* and 127 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

**HEREBY ORDERS** the Defence to file a Response to the Motion, if any, before 1200 hours on Monday, 14 January 2008.
