

**PROSECUTION'S NOTICE RELATING TO A MEETING BETWEEN
LOUISE ARBOUR AND GENERAL WESLEY CLARK**

On 9 April 2009, the Trial Chamber ordered the Prosecution to “disclose to the Accused any transcript or report of a meeting between Louise Arbour and General Wesley Clark at NATO headquarters in which Clark referred to the existence of an agreement by which the Accused would not be prosecuted by this Tribunal, which are within the custody or control of the Prosecution, or to file notice that it has no such material”.¹ In accordance with the Trial Chamber’s order, the Prosecution gives notice that it has no such material.
