ORDER ASSIGNING A CASE TO A TRIAL CHAMBER

I, **FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the Indictment in the case *Prosecutor v. Radovan Karadžić*, Case No. IT-95-5/18-I;¹

NOTING that the Registry has advised that the Accused, Radovan Karadžić, has been arrested and will be shortly transferred to the seat of the International Tribunal pursuant to Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”);


NOTING that Rule 62 of the Rules requires that the President of the International Tribunal forthwith assign the case to a Trial Chamber;

HEREBY ASSIGN, effective on the date upon which Radovan Karadžić is transferred to the seat of the International Tribunal, the case *Prosecutor v. Radovan Karadžić*, Case No. IT-95-5/18-I, to Trial Chamber I;

RECALL also that, pursuant to Rule 62 of the Rules, the initial appearance of the Accused shall be held without delay before Trial Chamber I or a permanent Judge thereof.
