**DECISION ON URGENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO DISCLOSE
EXPERT REPORT OF ANDRÁS RIEDLMAYER**


THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) is seised of an “Urgent Motion for an Extension of Time to Disclose the Expert Report of Andrés Riedlmayer” filed by the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) on 24 April 2009 (“Motion”), and hereby renders its decision thereon.

1. In the Motion, the Prosecution requests an extension of time to disclose the expert report of Andrés Riedlmayer on the basis that (i) he has acquired additional documentation for his report and is in the process of updating his database, and (ii) the database, once complete, will be too large to send electronically and will, therefore, require extra time to be sent by courier. The Prosecution seeks an extension of seven days, thus moving the deadline for disclosure from 30 April to 7 May 2009.¹

2. Pursuant to an order from the pre-trial Judge, the Accused filed a “Response to Motion for Extension of Time: Andras Riedlmayer” on 28 April 2009 (“Response”), in which he does not oppose the Motion.²

3. The Chamber considers that the Prosecution has shown good cause for an extension of time in this particular case. Accordingly, pursuant to Rules 54, 94 *bis*, and 127 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Trial Chamber hereby **GRANTS** the Motion and **ORDERS** the Prosecution to disclose the expert report of Andrés Riedlmayer’s by no later than 7 May 2009.
