THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

BEING SEISED OF the Accused’s “Request for Leave to Reply: Motion to Admit Documents Previously Marked for Identification”, filed on 24 September 2010 (“Request”);
