THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

BEING SEISED of the request of the Tribunal’s Registrar in the “Registrar’s Submission Regarding the Decision on Accused’s Request for Review of Registrar’s Decision on Indigence” filed on 18 November 2014 (“Request”), asking the Chamber to consider issuing a public redacted version of the “Decision on Accused’s Request for Review of Registrar’s Decision on Indigence” issued confidentially and *ex parte* on 25 February 2014 (“Decision”);¹

NOTING that the Registrar submits in the Request that it would be in the interests of justice to lift the confidentiality of the Decision as it “contains findings on many principles that are not only important for the public at large, but also for other accused before the Tribunal and the Mechanism for International Criminal Tribunals” but proposes a number of redactions in order to protect the privacy of the Accused;²

NOTING the Accused’s “Response to Registrar’s Request for Public Redacted Version of Decision” filed confidentially and *ex parte* on 24 November 2014, wherein he does not object to the Request but suggests on the one hand that an additional term be redacted but that some of the other redactions proposed by the Registrar are not necessary;³

CONSIDERING that it is in the interests of justice to issue a public redacted version of the Decision so that the public is informed of the findings therein;

HEREBY GRANTS the Request in part and **DECIDES** that a public redacted version of the Decision shall be filed.
