NOTING the Prosecution’s submission that it seeks to reply to elements of the Accused’s Response and address the application of Rule 50 of the Rules;

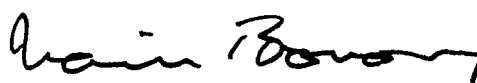
NOTING the Prosecution’s undertaking that the reply would be filed no later than 4 February 2009;
