
The Accused

I, **O-Gon Kwon**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) being seised of the Accused’s “Motion to Recuse Judge Melville Baird”, filed on 22 September 2009 (“Motion”), hereby render this order in relation thereto.

1. In the Motion the Accused seeks the disqualification of Judge Melville Baird from sitting in the present case, on the basis of the provisions of Article 13 of the Statute and Judge Baird’s age.
2. In light of the anticipated commencement of trial on 19 October 2009, and to facilitate an expeditious determination of the Motion, I would be assisted by a written response from the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) to the Motion within a truncated time period.
3. Accordingly, pursuant to Rules 54 and 126 *bis* of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence, I hereby **ORDER** the Prosecution to file its response to the Motion, if any, by 25 September 2009.
