I, O-Gon Kwon, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

BEING ASSIGNED Pre-Trial Judge in the present case pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”) by my order of 2 September 2009;¹

NOTING that at the last Status Conference, held on 8 September 2009, I indicated that the trial in the present case would commence on 19 October 2009, and that there would be a pre-trial conference on 6 October 2009;


CONSIDERING that the Accused has lodged an appeal against the Trial Chamber’s decision on the commencement of trial, which is pending before the Appeals Chamber;²

CONSIDERING that, whatever the outcome of the appeal, it is in the interests of efficient trial preparation for a pre-trial conference to be held, pursuant to Rule 73 *bis* of the Rules, on the date envisaged by the Trial Chamber;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54, 65 *ter* (B), and 73 *bis* of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULE the pre-trial conference for **Tuesday, 6 October 2009** at 2:15 p.m. in Courtroom 1.
