THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

CONSIDERING the “Decision on the Prosecution’s Motion to Subpoena Berko Zečević” issued confidentially on 20 January 2011 (“Decision”), in which this Trial Chamber granted, in part, the confidential “Prosecution’s Motion to Subpoena, and for Video-Conference Link for the Testimony of, Berko Zečević With Confidential Appendices A, B and C” (“Motion”), filed on 10 January 2011, requesting that a subpoena be issued directing Witness Berko Zečević to appear before the Trial Chamber to give oral testimony beginning on 2 February 2011;

PURSUANT TO Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 54 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”);

HEREBY REQUESTS the responsible authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina:

1. To serve the attached Subpoena issued by the Trial Chamber on 20 January 2011 (“Subpoena”):

2. To take all reasonable and necessary measures to ensure that the above-named witness appears at the time and place indicated in the Subpoena;

3. To provide a confidential written report either confirming, and providing details of, the actual service of the Subpoena or describing the efforts made to serve the Subpoena, and further describing the efforts made to ensure the appearance of the above-named witness;

4. To provide passport information concerning the witness within 48 hours of receipt of this Order;

5. Not to disclose to any third party the existence or content of the Subpoena or any related document until such time as:
- (i) the above-named witness appears before the Tribunal; or
 - (ii) the confidentiality of the Subpoena and this Order is lifted.
