**ORDER LIFTING CONFIDENTIALITY OF DECISION ON SECOND SITE VISIT
AND RELATED PLEADINGS**

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

NOTING its “Decision on Second Site Visit” filed confidentially on 10 February 2012 (“Decision”), in which it ordered, *inter alia*, that a site visit to locations in and around Srebrenica would take place at the end of May or the beginning of June 2012 (“Srebrenica Site Visit”) and that the “confidentiality of all site visit related pleadings shall be maintained until further order of the Chamber”;¹

NOTING that, pursuant to Rules 78 and 79 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), all proceedings must be public unless there are exceptional reasons for keeping them confidential;

CONSIDERING that, given the Srebrenica Site Visit has now been completed, there are no longer exceptional reasons for the Decision and all related pleadings to remain confidential;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS

PURSUANT to Article 21(2) of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rules 78 and 79 of the Rules

HEREBY ORDERS the Registry to lift the confidentiality of the:

- 1) Decision;
- 2) Following portion of the transcript and audio-visual record: T. 23481 line 15 to 23482 line 7 (24 January 2012);
- 3) “Defence Submission on Srebrenica Site Visit, confidential”, filed by the Accused on 31 January 2012;
- 4) “Prosecution’s Third Submission on Site Visit”, filed by the Office of the Prosecutor on 31 January 2012; and

- 5) “Submission by Standby Counsel in Response to Trial Chamber’s Invitation to Parties to Address Issues Related to Possible Site Visit”, filed by the Standby Counsel on 31 January 2012.
