I, Judge Fouad Riad, Judge of Trial Chamber I,

PURSUANT TO Rule 15 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING the indictment against Ivan ŠANTIĆ confirmed on 10 November 1995 (hereafter "Indictment");

CONSIDERING the Motion for leave to withdraw the indictment against the accused Ivan ŠANTIĆ submitted by the Prosecutor on 18 December 1997 pursuant to Rule 51 (hereafter "Motion");

CONSIDERING the response of the Defence dated 19 December 1997;

CONSIDERING the hearing held on 19 December 1997;

CONSIDERING that the emergency of the situation justifies that the order be issued by single judge of Trial Chamber;

CONSIDERING that the Motion of the Prosecutor addresses the fundamental rights of the accused and, in particular, the issue of individual freedom;

CONSIDERING that, in accordance with the Statute and the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Prosecutor has the right to conduct her investigations;

CONSIDERING that the Prosecutor believes that there is not sufficient evidence to ensure a fair trial;

CONSIDERING that the Defence has consented to the Motion of the Prosecutor in its Response;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

ORDERS that the Indictment against Ivan ŠANTIĆ be withdrawn in accordance with Rule 51 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

THEREFORE DIRECTS that Ivan ŠANTIĆ be immediately released.
