## RADISLAV KRSTIĆ (SREBRENICA CASE) TRANSFERRED TO THE UNITED KINGDOM TO SERVE HIS PRISON SENTENCE

Today, 20 December 2004, Radislav Krstić was transferred to the United Kingdom to serve his sentence, as handed down by the Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY).

On 19 April 2004, Radislav Krstić was sentenced to 35 years' imprisonment following his conviction for aiding and abetting the genocide committed at Srebrenica in July 1995(see Press Release 839e).

Fifteen other accused have been transferred and are serving their sentences: Duško Sikirica and Mitar Vasiljević in Austria; Duško Tadić and Dragoljub Kunarac in Germany; Stevan Todorović, Drago Josipović, Vladimir Šantić and Darko Mrđa in Spain; Zoran Vuković, Radomir Kovač and Dragan Obrenović in Norway; Goran Jelisić in Italy; Biljana Plavšić in Sweden; and Hazim Delić and Esad Lanžo in Finland.
