I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the “Order Assigning a Case to a Trial Chamber” of 20 February 2006, whereby I assigned the case *Prosecutor v. Milan Lukić and Sredoje Lukić*, Case No. IT-98-32/1-PT, to Trial Chamber III;

NOTING the composition of Trial Chamber III of the International Tribunal as set out in document IT/245 issued on 12 May 2006;

NOTING that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;


NOTING, further, that Rule 27(C) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to temporarily assign a member of a Trial Chamber or of the Appeals Chamber to another Chamber;

CONSIDERING the trial management and case distribution needs of the International Tribunal;

HEREBY ASSIGN, with immediate effect, Judge Christine Van den Wyngaert to Trial Chamber III for the purposes of the case *Prosecutor v. Milan Lukić and Sredoje Lukić*, Case No. IT-98-32/1-PT.
