**I, O-Gon Kwon**, Acting President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the letter from Vojislav Šešelj in which he requests review of a decision of the Registrar dated 10 September 2009 (“Request”);

**NOTING** the “Registry Submission Pursuant to Rule 33(B) Regarding the Accused’s Submission No. 425”, filed 23 September 2009;

**CONSIDERING** that President Patrick Robinson has informed me that his prior role as Presiding Judge of the Pre-Trial Bench in the present case gives rise to a conflict of interest and that, in accordance with Rule 15(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”), he shall therefore withdraw from considering the Request;

**CONSIDERING** that my role as the Presiding Judge in *Prosecutor v. Šešelj*, Case No. IT-03-67-R-77.2, may give rise to a conflict of interest in the circumstances of this matter and that, in accordance with Rule 15(A) of the Rules, I therefore withdraw from considering the Request;

**CONSIDERING** further that President Patrick Robinson is currently absent from the International Tribunal and that, pursuant to Rule 21 of the Rules, the Vice-President shall exercise the functions of the President in case of the latter’s absence or inability to act;

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 21 of the Rules;

**HEREBY ASSIGN**, with immediate effect, Judge Mehmet Güney to consider the Request in place of myself.
