**I, Jean-Claude Antonetti**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**CONSIDERING** that the Accused Vojislav Šešelj (“Accused”) began a hunger strike on 11 November 2006,<sup>1</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Accused announced that he was ending his hunger strike as of 8 December 2006,<sup>2</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that it seems necessary to have a report on the state of health of the Accused prior to his appearance for a status conference;

**FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,**

**REQUEST** the Registrar to provide without delay a report on the current state of health of the Accused and to inform me whether the Accused is in a position to appear for a status conference on short notice.
