I, Jean-Claude Antonetti, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the order of 22 February 2007 whereby the Presiding Judge of the Trial Chamber designated me as Pre-Trial Judge,¹

CONSIDERING that pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* (A) of the Rules, the Pre-Trial Judge shall convene a status conference at least every one hundred and twenty days,

CONSIDERING that the last status conference was held on 2 May 2007,

CONSIDERING that during that last status conference the Pre-Trial Judge expressed his intention to hold status conferences every two to three weeks in order to prepare the trial,

PURSUANT TO Rule 65 *bis* (A) of the Rules,

ORDER that a status conference be held on 22 May 2007 from 1530 hours in courtroom I.
