**I, Jean-Claude Antonetti**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

**NOTING** the Order of the President of the Trial Chamber of 22 February 2007, assigning a Pre-Trial Judge.

**CONSIDERING** that pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Pre-Trial Judge shall convene a status conference at least once every one hundred and twenty days.

**CONSIDERING** that the next status conference shall be held on 5 June 2007 and that, during the status conference of 2 May 2007 the Pre-Trial Judge declared his intention to hold status conferences every two or three weeks with a view to preparing the trial;

**PURSUANT TO** Article 65 *bis* A) of the Rules,

**ORDER** that a status conference be held on Wednesday 4 July 2007 at 0900 hours in Courtroom 3.
