PROPRIO MOTU

NOTING the Order for Clarification of Two Prosecution Motions for Judicial Notice of Documentary Evidence, issued by the Chamber on 5 February 2008 (“Order”);

CONSIDERING that in the footer on pages 1 to 3 of the Order, the date appearing as “5 February 2007” should instead read “5 February 2008”;

CONSIDERING furthermore that on page 3 of the Order, the words “Done this day and month in letters and year in numbers” should instead read “Done this fifth day of February 2008”;

FOR THESE REASONS,

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules,

ORDERS that:
