THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that, pursuant to the Scheduling Order of 22 May 2009, the trial will commence on Friday 29 May 2009;¹


