I, **KIMBERLY PROST**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

BEING SEISED OF the “Prosecution Filing of Pre-Trial Brief Pursuant to Rule 65 *ter* (E)”, filed under seal on 28 November 2008 (“Filing of Pre-Trial Brief”);

NOTING that in the Filing of Pre-Trial Brief the Prosecution made a request to be allowed to exceed the stated word limit for the Pre-Trial Brief (“Request”);¹


NOTING that the Filing of Pre-Trial Brief has not yet been translated into Bosnian-Croatian-Serbian (“BCS”);

NOTING that at the Status Conference held on 27 February 2009, I issued an oral order to be confirmed in writing with regard to the timing of submissions by the Accused on the Request;²

PURSUANT TO Rule 126 *bis* of the Rules,

HEREBY ORDER that the Accused may submit a response to the Request within seven days of the date on which the Accused receives the BCS translation of the Filing of Pre-Trial Brief.
