THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that on 18 March 2010, PW-017 testified pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*(C);


NOTING that it came to the Chamber’s attention that only a confidential version of PW-017’s prior testimony in the *Krstić* case was tendered and admitted into evidence¹ and that it is therefore necessary to have its public version of the transcript on the record;

NOTING that the Accused informed the Chamber through his legal advisor that he had no objection to the admission of the public version;²

HEREBY orders as follows:

- (1) the public version of PW-017’s prior testimony in the *Krstić* case shall be admitted into evidence; and
- (2) the Registry assign it an exhibit number.
