I, **FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the Indictment in the case *Prosecutor v. Stojan Župljanin*, Case No. IT-99-36-I;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** that the Registry has advised that the Accused, Stojan Župljanin, has been arrested and will be shortly transferred to the seat of the International Tribunal pursuant to Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”);


**NOTING** that Rule 62 of the Rules requires that the President of the International Tribunal forthwith assign the case to a Trial Chamber;

**HERBY ASSIGN**, effective on the date upon which Stojan Župljanin is transferred to the seat of the International Tribunal, the case *Prosecutor v. Stojan Župljanin*, Case No. IT-99-36-I, to Trial Chamber II;

**RECALL** also that, pursuant to Rule 62 of the Rules, the initial appearance of the Accused shall be held without delay before Trial Chamber II or a permanent Judge thereof.
