I. OVERVIEW OF SELECTED COURT DOCUMENTS:

Stanislav GALIĆ Case (“Sarajevo”)

Appeals Chamber – Judges Hunt (Presiding), Güney, Gunawardana, Pocar and Meron

DECISION ON INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL CONCERNING RULE 92bis(C)

On 7 June 2002, the Appeals Chamber allowed the appeal against the Trial Chamber’s Decision of 12 April 2002 (see *Weekly Update* No. 216).

The appeal against the Trial Chamber’s Decision of 18 April 2002 (see *Weekly Update* No. 216) was dismissed.

Trial Chamber II Section A - Judges Agius (Presiding), Janů and Taya

DECISION ON MOTION TO SET ASIDE CONFIDENTIAL SUBPOENA TO GIVE EVIDENCE

On 8 May 2002, journalist Jonathan Randal confidentially filed written submissions to Set Aside the Confidential Subpoena to Give Evidence. In this submission and during the hearing on 10 May 2002 (see *Weekly Update* No. 219) Randal argued that international criminal justice would be restricted if journalists were routinely compelled to give evidence against individuals they interviewed while covering a conflict. On 7 June 2002, the Trial Chamber dismissed the Motion.

Pavle STRUGAR and Miodrag JOKIĆ Case (“Dubrovnik”)

Trial Chamber I – Judges Liu (Presiding), El Mahdi and Orić

DECISION ON DEFENCE PRELIMINARY MOTION CHALLENGING JURISDICTION

On 18 January 2002, Pavle Strugar filed a Motion under Rule 72 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence challenging the jurisdiction of the Tribunal. Strugar argued that the offences of attacks on civilians and unlawful attacks on civilian objects did not, at the relevant times, fall within the purview of customary international law. Strugar further argued that the Additional Protocols of 1949 did not bind either party to the conflict as a matter of treaty law during the Indictment period. On 7 June 2002, the Trial Chamber dismissed the Motion.

Paško LJUBIČIĆ Case (“Lašva Valley”)

Trial Chamber I – Judges Liu (Presiding), El Mahdi and Orić

DECISION ON THE DEFENCE OBJECTIONS ON CORRECTED AMENDED INDICTMENT

On 7 June 2002, the Trial Chamber partially granted the Defence Motion and ordered the Prosecution to amend the Indictment within the terms set out in the Order and to file a second amended Indictment within 14 days of the Order. The accused was given 14 days from the date of the Prosecution’s filing to submit further observations.

Dušan FUŠTAR, Predrag BANOVIĆ and Duško KNEŽEVIĆ Case (“Keraterm Camp”)

Trial Chamber III - May (Presiding), Robinson and Kwon

ORDER ON DEFENCE MOTION FOR MEDICAL EXAMINATION

On 7 June 2002, the Trial Chamber granted the Motion and ordered a medical examination of the accused Predrag Banović. The Trial Chamber instructed the Registrar to entrust the examination to an expert whose name appears on the list drawn up by Registry.

Dragoljub KUNARAC, Radomir KOVAČ and Zoran VUKOVIĆ Case (“Foča”)

Appeals Chamber - Judges Jorda (Presiding), Shahabuddeen, Schomburg, Güney and Meron

JUDGEMENT

On 12 June 2002, the Appeals Chamber rendered a Judgement confirming Trial Chamber II's judgement of 22 February 2002. The Appeals Chamber dismissed all the grounds of appeal and affirmed the sentences imposed by the Trial Chamber: 28 years' imprisonment for Dragoljub Kunarac, 20 years' imprisonment for Radomir Kovač and 12 years' imprisonment for Zoran Vuković (See *Press Release* No. 679).
