I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the Application submitted to me by the Panel of the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina and filed on 24 August 2007, seeking access to witnesses’ testimonies, which are available in BCS language, from the *Blagojević and Jokić* trial;


CONSIDERING Rule 75(H) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal, as amended on 12 July 2007;

CONSIDERING that the Appeals Chamber rendered its Judgement in this case on 9 May 2007;

HEREBY ASSIGN, with immediate effect, Trial Chamber I to consider the Application from the Panel of the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina seeking the variation or rescinding of protective measures granted with regard to certain testimonies in *Prosecutor v. Vidoje Blagojević and Dragan Jokić*, Case No. IT-02-60-A.
