## DECISION

## THE REGISTRAR,

CONSIDERING the Statute of the Tribunal as adopted by the Security Council under Resolution 827 (1993), and in particular Article 21 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Rules of Procedure and Evidence as adopted by the Tribunal on 11 February 1994, as subsequently amended, and in particular Rules 44 and 45 thereof;

CONSIDERING the Directive on Assignment of Defence Counsel (hereinafter "the Directive") as adopted by the Tribunal on 28 July 1994, as subsequently amended, and in particular, Articles 6, 8, 11 (A) (i) and 18 ;

CONSIDERING the request of Mr. Momir Nikolić (hereinafter "the accused") dated 10 April 2002 to have Mr. Veselin Londrović, attorney at law from Bijeljina, appointed as his lead counsel and the request of Mr. Londrović to have Mr. Stefan Kirsch, attorney at law from Frankfurt, assigned as co-counsel to the accused;

NOTING the decisions of the Registrar dated 17 April 2002 and 28 May 2002 assigning Mr. Londrović and Mr. Kirsch as lead counsel and co-counsel for a period of 120 and 77 days in order to secure the rights of the accused while verifying his declaration of indigency;

CONSIDERING that in accordance with his declaration of means dated 3 April 2002, the accused is married, has two children of 20 and 11 years of age, is unemployed since November 2000 and does not receive any unemployment benefits;

CONSIDERING that according to the documents submitted to the Registry, the total personal income of the accused and his wife for the years 2000 and 2001 amounts to approximately 11 300 KM;

CONSIDERING that the accused has declared that he supports his wife, his two children and his mother in law;

CONSIDERING that the relevant authorities of Republika Srpska have certified that the accused is the owner of a 130 square meters house valued at approximately 43 600 KM and of a plot of land of 2100 square meters in Bratunac Municipality;

**DECIDES** without prejudice to Article 18 of the Directive, to assign Mr. Londrović and Mr. Kirsch as lead counsel and co-counsel to the accused.
