I, Mohamed Fassi Fihri, Judge at the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (hereinafter "the International Tribunal"),

NOTING that I have been designated Pre-Trial Judge in this instance in accordance with an Order issued by the Trial Chamber on 28 August 2001,

NOTING the Prosecution Request regarding disclosure of supporting material filed on 14 September 2001 (hereinafter "the Request") in which it asks that the time-limits for disclosing supporting material be extended until 17 September 2001,

NOTING the correspondence appended to the Request in which Mr. Karnavas, Counsel for the Defence (hereinafter "the Defence"), consents to the filing of the Request seeking an extension of the time-limit until Monday, 17 September 2001,

CONSIDERING that, in the circumstances, the reasons put forward in support of the Request constitute good cause within the meaning of Rule 127 of the Rules,

PURSUANT to Rule 127 of the Rules,

GRANT the Request and **ORDER** that the Prosecution disclose the supporting material to the Defence on the date agreed by the parties.
