**I, MEHMET GÜNEY**, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) and Pre-Appeal Judge in the present case,<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the Judgement rendered by Trial Chamber II in the case *Prosecutor v. Ljube Bošković and Johan Tarčulovski*, Case No. IT-04-82-T, on 10 July 2008;

**CONSIDERING** that, pursuant to Rule 65bis (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”) a status conference should be convened within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;

**CONSIDERING** that the last status conference in this case was held on 18 March 2009;

**PURSUANT** to Rule 65bis (B) of the Rules,

**HEREBY ORDER** that a status conference shall be held before me on Thursday, 16 July 2009, at 14:30 in Courtroom II.
