NOTING that Johan Tarčulovski is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending appeal;


CONSIDERING that pursuant to Rule 65bis (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal, a status conference shall be convened within 120 days of the filing of a notice of appeal to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the physical and mental condition of that person;

ORDER that a status conference shall be held before me on Monday 1 December 2008 at noon in Courtroom 2;

FURTHER ORDER Counsel for Johan Tarčulovski, Mr. Nathan Z. Dershowitz, to file a written statement confirming his oral request to participate to the status conference by telephone conference rather than in person by Monday 24 November 2008, should he maintain his request.
