I, Alphons Orie, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber I of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

HEREBY ORDER that, subject to any further order of the Trial Chamber:


