**I, JUDGE CARMEL AGIUS**, Presiding Judge in a Specially Appointed Chamber (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**NOTING** the Order in Lieu of Indictment of 27 August 2008 (“Order”);

**NOTING** that **FLORENCE HARTMANN** (“Accused”), in the Order, was summoned to appear before the Chamber at 15.00 on 15 September 2008 in Courtroom I;

**NOTING** the scheduling order of 10 September 2008, according to which the initial appearance was rescheduled to 14.15 on 13 October 2008 in Courtroom III;

**NOTING** the scheduling order of 26 September 2008, according to which the initial appearance was rescheduled to 16.30 on 27 October 2008 in Courtroom I;

**CONSIDERING** Rule 81 (D) of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) which provides that photography, video-recording or audio-recording of the trial, otherwise than by the Registrar, may be authorized at the discretion of the Chamber;

**PURSUANT TO** Rules 54 and 81 (D) of the Rules;

**HEREBY ORDER** that, subject to any further order of the Chamber:

1. the taking of still photographs by designated photographers at the commencement of all proceedings in this matter is authorized as directed by the Chief of Security of the Tribunal’s Security Service; and
2. the audio-visual record of all open sessions in this case, as provided by the Registrar of the Tribunal, may be released to the media.
