I, **JUDGE CARMEL AGIUS**, Presiding Judge in a Specially Appointed Chamber (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Order in Lieu of an Indictment on Contempt in the case against Florence Hartmann, Case No. IT-02-54-R77.5, filed on 27 August 2008 (“Order”);

NOTING the Scheduling Order for Initial Appearance, filed on 26 September 2008, summoning Florence Hartmann (“Accused”) to appear before the Chamber on 27 October 2008, at 16.30 in Courtroom I.

PURSUANT to Rule 62(A) of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) which provides that an accused shall be brought before the Trial Chamber to which the case is assigned or a Judge thereof without delay, and shall be formally charged;
