THE SPECIALLY APPOINTED CHAMBER (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that the Pre-trial Trial Conference in the case against Florence Hartmann (“the Accused”) commenced on 15 June 2009 and was followed immediately by the Prosecution case;

NOTING that the Prosecution case was closed on 16 June 2009 and that the Defence case started on the same day, continuing into 17 June 2009;

NOTING that due to the availability of Judges, on 17 June 2009, the Presiding Judge directed the parties that trial will continue on 1 July 2009, to finish the evidence of the final Defence witness;¹


PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Chamber **ORDERS** as follows;

1. The Trial against the Accused shall continue on 1 July 2009, at 9.00 hours in Courtroom I, to hear the remainder of the evidence of the final Defence witness, Nataša Kandić;
2. The parties shall file their Final Briefs, which shall not exceed 15,000 words, by 2 July 2009;
3. On 3 July 2009 Court will commence at 9.00 hours in Courtroom I and adjourn at 12.00 hours. The parties shall have 60 minutes each to present their final arguments.
