I, Alphons Orié, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber I of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Order of 16 April 2008 composing the Trial Chamber;


NOTING that the Accused is being transferred to the seat of the Tribunal;

HEREBY ORDER that the initial appearance of the Accused shall be held on 21 May 2008 at 14.15 hours in Courtroom I.
