TRIAL CHAMBER I of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that **SHEFQET KABASHI** (“the Accused”) was arrested in the Kingdom of the Netherlands on 17 August 2011 and transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 18 August 2011;

NOTING that the initial appearance of the Accused has been scheduled for 19 August 2011;


CONSIDERING Rule 81 (D) of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) which provides that photography, video-recording or audio-recording of the trial, otherwise than by the Registrar, may be authorized by the Chamber;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 81 (D) of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS that, subject to any further order of the Chamber:

1. the taking of still photographs by designated photographers at the commencement of all proceedings in this matter is authorized as directed by the Chief of Security of the Tribunal’s Security Service; and
2. the release of the audio-visual record of all open sessions in this case is permitted as provided by the Registrar of the Tribunal.
