NOTING the Order in lieu of indictment in the case No. IT-03-67-R77.1, issued confidentially by

the Trial Chamber on 13 May 2008;

NOTING that Ljubiša Petković was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 28 May 2008;

NOTING the Order issued on 23 May 2008 by the Vice-President of the Tribunal, acting on behalf

of the President of the Tribunal, assigning the case against Ljubiša Petković ("Accused") to Trial

Chamber III;

NOTING the Order issued by the Trial Chamber on 28 May 2008 lifting the confidentiality of the

proceedings against Ljubiša Petković;

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

HEREBY ORDERS the detention on remand of the Accused and enjoins the Commanding Officer

of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
