THIS CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

NOTING the Order issued confidentially and *ex parte* on 29 October 2008 by the President of the Tribunal, directing this Chamber to examine the "Prosecution's Motion under Rule 77 Concerning the Breach of Protective Measures", filed confidentially and *ex parte* before Trial Chamber III on 10 October 2008 in the case of *Prosecutor v. Vojislav Šešelj*;

NOTING the Order in lieu of an Indictment issued on 21 January 2009 against Vojislav Šešelj ("Accused") on one count of contempt of the Tribunal, punishable under Rule 77(A)(ii) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules"), for knowingly and wilfully disclosing information in knowing violation of an order of a Chamber;¹

NOTING that the initial appearance of the Accused was held on 6 March 2009 and that the trial proceedings in the present case were conducted on 29 May 2009;

NOTING that the Chamber thereafter withdrew for deliberations pursuant to Rule 87(A);

PURSUANT to Rule 98ter of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS that the Judgement in the present case shall be delivered on Friday 24 July 2009, at 2.15 p.m. in Courtroom I.
