**ORDER FOR RELEASE OF AUDIO-VISUAL RECORD AND  
PERMITTING PHOTOGRAPHY**

**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**NOTING** the “Public Redacted Version of Second Decision on Prosecution’s Motion Under Rule 77 Concerning Further Breaches of protective Measures (Three Books) Issued on 3 February 2010” of 4 February 2010, and the annexed order in lieu of indictment wherein the Trial Chamber initiated contempt proceedings against Vojislav Šešelj (“Accused”) by charging him with one count of contempt of the Tribunal, punishable under Rule 77(A)(ii) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”), for having disclosed information which may identify 11 protected witnesses in violation of orders of a Chamber in a book;

**NOTING** the Order issued by the Trial Chamber on 9 March 2010, scheduling the initial appearance of the Accused for 20 April 2010 at 9 a.m. in Courtroom I;

**HAVING CONSIDERED** the request of certain members of the press;

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 81(D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that, subject to any further order of the Trial Chamber:

1. the taking of still photographs by designated press photographers at the commencement of all proceedings in this matter is authorised as directed by the Chief of Security of the Tribunal’s Security Service; and
2. the release of the audio-visual record of all open sessions in this case is permitted as provided by the Registrar of the Tribunal.
