I, GUY DELVOIE, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

HAVING BEEN designated as duty Judge for this period pursuant to Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”),

NOTING the Indictment in *Prosecutor v. Zuhdija Tabaković*, filed on 30 October 2009 and confirmed on 17 November 2009,


NOTING that Zuhdija Tabaković (“the Accused”) was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 18 December 2009,

FINDING that the matter is of an urgent character, and that I am therefore competent to dispose of this matter in my capacity as duty Judge,

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules,

HEREBY ORDER the detention on remand of the Accused and enjoin the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit of the Tribunal in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
