ORDER FOR DETENTION ON REMAND

The Accused:

Berko Zečević

I, O-Gon Kwon, Judge of this Trial Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

NOTING the Order in Lieu of Indictment in the Contempt Case of Berko Zečević issued by the Chamber on 4 February 2011 ("Order in Lieu of Indictment"); ¹

NOTING the Warrant of Arrest and Order for Surrender for Berko Zečević ("Accused") issued on 4 February 2011 directing the competent authorities of the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina to search for, arrest, detain, and surrender him promptly to the Tribunal;²

CONSIDERING that the Accused was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 17 February 2011;

CONSIDERING that the initial appearance of the Accused will be held on 18 February 2011 pursuant to Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules");

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDER the detention on remand of the Accused and instruct the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
